- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks after application deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4-6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

1. Grading systems of the institutions

UK LONDON031

Each module will display a percentage mark (to one decimal place) and a module grade. Queen Mary uses a number of mark schemes for different awards and different levels and although many of the grades are the same, there are differences between the qualifying pass marks for undergraduate and postgraduate students.

The Queen Mary **undergraduate** grading system uses five letter grades (A-E) to indicate the various levels of passes. 'A' grades are exceptional and a 'B' is considered a good grade, 'C' an average grade. 'D' is a passing grade but must be regarded as below average, and 'E' is a bare pass. 'F' indicates a fail.
